Mobility scooters are welcome on our trams, but please follow our guidance for safe parking on board.



Mobility scooters:

If your scooter fits, please use the wheelchair space, ideally facing the direction of travel. Mobility scooters should avoid parking side-facing where possible, as the tram may need to brake suddenly which may cause you and your scooter to fall. If you must park side-facing, park next to the nearest handrail, **keeping it between you and the driver**, and hold on during the journey.

Wheelchair users:

Park in the designated space with your back towards the backplate and apply the brakes.

Before you board

- Tap your pass or bank card on the validator or buy your ticket.
- Use the help point at the tram stop to let us know if you need more time to get on.
- Wait safely on the platform behind the yellow line.
- When boarding, the flashing lights and sounds signal the doors are closing.

On the tram

- Take a seat if you can, priority seating is available.
- There are two designated spaces on each tram for wheelchair users.
- Hold on at all times throughout the journey.
- There's a blue stop button by the wheelchair space that opens all doors at the next stop.
